### Guided Reading Prompts and Questions to Improve ...

Guided reading questions can help prompt discussions during your small group instructional time. Deeper comprehension and meaningful connections occur when you teach students to ask the right questions before, during and after reading. To begin with, a KWL chart or graphic organizer can help students set a purpose for reading before they start.

In advance, prepare a teaching point, discussion questions, and (if desired) an extension such as word work or guided writing. Before the students begin reading, introduce the text. You might introduce new concepts or vocabulary words, give a brief synopsis of the book, call attention to a new phonics pattern, have your learners do a picture ...

### Before, during & after guided reading activities - The ...

Read a book or text to the class, and model your thinking and questioning. Emphasize that even though you are an adult reader, questions before, during, and after reading continue to help you gain an understanding of the text you are reading. Ask questions such as: "What clues does the title give me about the story?"

### Questions Before, During, and After Reading ...

Before reading, use these prompts help students think about what they are reading before they begin. ☐ Think about the title/genre/author/pictures/setting. What do you think the story/book will be about?
